



## Saltzer Health provides COVID-19 vaccines at clinics in Meridian & Caldwell

COVID-19 vaccines are available at Saltzer Health urgent care clinics in Meridian and Caldwell.

Saltzer Health is adhering to federal guidelines and the recommendations of the Governor's Idaho COVID-19 Vaccine Advisory Committee (CVAC) for distribution of the COVID-19 vaccine.

The COVID vaccine is currently being provided to:

- Healthcare workers
- First responders (firefighters/police/safety workers)
- Correctional and detention facility staff (other than medical)
- Pre-kindergarten through 12th-grade staff and teachers, and daycare workers (childcare workers).

Proof of eligibility is required to schedule an appointment and receive a vaccine. To ensure a seamless, efficient process, bring these items with you for your appointment:

- Driver's License or alternate legal ID
- Medical insurance card
- Proof of employment (pay stub, business card, or employee badge)

The urgent care clinic hours and locations are:

Depending on the availability of the vaccine, the next phases of the vaccine distribution authorized by Gov. Little are:

Feb. 1, 2021

- Adults age 65 and older
- Food and agriculture workers
- Food processing workers & USDA processing plant inspectors
- Grocery, convenience store, and food pantry workers
- Idaho National Guard not already included as healthcare personnel
- Manufacturing workers
- Public transit workers
- U.S. Postal Service workers

March/April 2021

- People age 16-64 years with medical conditions that increase the risk for severe COVID-19

May 1, 2021

- General public 16 years of age and older
