RELEASE OF INFORMATION

Background Information

I further understand that the Nampa Police Department will evaluate any conviction(s) based upon the position for which I am applying.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, do hereby request to be a volunteer with the Nampa Police Department. If permission is granted, I agree to obey all instructions, orders, and commands given to me by any officer(s). I fully realize and appreciate the basic nature of law enforcement work and the possibility that situations may arise which might result in my being exposed to the danger of physical injury or harm. I nevertheless freely and voluntarily assume these risks. I further agree to keep confidential any information I may acquire while working as a volunteer.

WHEREFORE, in consideration for the opportunity to be a volunteer with the Nampa Police Department, I hereby waive, release and discharge all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of my participation as a NPD volunteer. This release discharges in advance the City of Nampa, its council members, the Nampa Police Department and its Chief, its employees, agents and servants from liability. This waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Confidentiality is essential for a Nampa Police Department (NPD) volunteer. **Anything** of a confidential nature that you see or hear while working with NPD must remain confidential.
2. As a NPD volunteer, you will receive a police identification badge and an access card. When working, you must wear your ID badge and keep it visible at all times. If you lose your ID badge or access card, you must report it immediately to the on-duty supervisor.
3. You must dress appropriately for the job you are doing. Usual dress will be “nice casual” which means nice pants or skirts, blouses or collared shirts, and closed-toe shoes. No t-shirts, jeans or sandals. Exceptions to the dress code will be made on a case-by-case basis depending upon whether the activity requires a different standard of dress.
4. You may not carry a firearm, even if you have a concealed weapons permit.
5. You may not operate vehicles or police equipment unless you are authorized to do so.
6. Photographs may be taken during NPD events/activities and the photos may be used on **NPD** or **NPD Volunteer** social media sites or for **NPD Volunteer** promotional material.
